In order to obtain reservations for this **UNUSUAL EVENT** we must make substantial non-refundable commitments far in advance. We cannot make exceptions to the cancellation policy for any reason including personal emergencies.

Day 1 • Departure

Evening departure on your overnight flight to Europe. Enjoy dinner aloft as you anticipate all the wonderful things to come.

Day 2 • Berlin

Welcome to Europe! We transfer to the hotel, relax, and enjoy the balance of the day at leisure.

Day 3 • Berlin

Morning sightseeing includes the Reichstag, which once housed the German Parliament, and Schloss Charlottenburg. View the Opera, the Schiller Theater, Brandenburg Gate, the “Wall” and the Kaiser Wilhelm Memorial Church. Afternoon is at leisure.

Day 4 • Wittenberg/Leipzig

This morning, following breakfast, proceed to Wittenberg, designated as “Lutherstadt” (“Luther Town”). It was here that Luther gained notoriety by posting his 95 theses to the door of the Castle Church, thus sparking the movement that would become the Reformation. This is Luther country, strongly associated with Reformation history. You will visit Leipzig, where Bach served as choirmaster for 25 years and is buried at Thomaskirche.

Day 5 • Eisleben/Erfurt/Eisenach

Along the way are the Luther sights in Eisleben and Erfurt, such as the flamboyant gothic Cathedral and the Augustinian Monastery where Luther was ordained.

Day 6 • Wartburg, Luther & Bach Historic Sites

Your sightseeing begins with a visit to the Bach House, where Johann Sebastian Bach was born, Luther House which is now a museum dedicated to the life of Luther, and Wartburg Castle, an imposing fortress where Luther translated the Bible into German.

Day 7 • Nuremberg

We continue toward Nurnberg and tour the Medieval City area with its 15th century restored Albrecht Duerer house, the market place, and its beautiful fountain decorated with a number of fine figures and the Church of Our Lady of gothic style with an old clock and its mechanical hours.

Day 8 • Oberammergau

We continue our travel through Germany where we will visit the Wies Kirche, the most beautiful Rococo church in Europe. We continue to the tiny Alpine village of Oberammergau, surrounded by towering mountains.

Day 9 • Oberammergau

This morning we enjoy a stroll through this charming village looking at picturesque buildings, admiring fine examples of handcrafted woodcarvings, and do some shopping. Then,

after lunch, we attend the highlight of our trip, the world famous Oberammergau Passion Play. After a dinner break, the amazing performance continues through the evening.

Day 10 • Oberammergau/Munich

You will leave Oberammergau and travel through the Alpine foothills past quaint towns and impressive castles, visiting King Ludwig’s Linderhof Castle. We will then continue on to Munich.

Day 11 • Munich

The morning’s tour of Germany’s most favored city” will take you to Nymphenburg Palace, the former residence of Bavarian kings. We’ll have time to explore the shopping areas and sample wonderful German cuisine. Other highlights include the Glockenspeil Tower’s quaint clockwork presentation of knights jousting and the Royal Residence whose treasure chamber houses the crown jewels. In the evening, you will enjoy a festive farewell dinner with authentic Bavarian folkloric entertainment.

Day 12 • Return Home

Bid a fond farewell to Europe today as you proceed to the airport for your flight home, bringing with you an abundance of special memories to treasure forever.

Oberammergau 2010

THE WORLD-RENOWNED PASSION PLAY takes place every ten years in the Alpine village of Oberammergau, nestled in a valley and surrounded by breathtaking vistas. Frescos of biblical themes painted on the walls of many of the houses enhance the quaintness of the village. As you leisurely stroll through the town you will see many fine examples of woodcarving and fresco painting—centuries old crafts that have been passed on in Oberammergau from generation to generation.

In the year 1633 Oberammergau was in the grip of the Black Plague. The inhabitants took an oath that they would stage a performance of the suffering of Jesus Christ every ten years if their village would be spared from the plague. The epidemic abated just short of the village and in thanksgiving the inhabitants fulfilled their oath by performing the first passion play in 1634.

For hundreds of years, in spite of dangers and threats, the village of Oberammergau kept the solemn promise. With determined faithfulness to this tradition the amateur actors, who are all residents of the village, are about to represent again the life and suffering of Christ in fulfillment of their ancestors’ vow. Pilgrims from all over the world will be inspired by the never-to-be forgotten Passion Play as a testimony of religious faith.
